No preset seeding teams due to 1<sup>st</sup> annual tournament. 4\*4 group draw will be released for public at 8pm, Monday Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019, all teams are strongly recommended to participation.

### Definitions

**EBTD** – Elite Badminton Tournament Directors

**Game** – International scoring system of rally points up to 31 points. At 30 – 30, the first team to reach 31 points wins the game.

**Match** – Refers to the 1 set only 31-point game.

**Tie** – Refers to the best of 6 matches played against another team.

### Player Eligibility

This tournament is open for people older than 25 years old (born before Dec 15, 1994)

Round Robin results will determine second day A/B division play.

No more than 2 players aged between 25 and 35 years old can participate in a tie play. They can player together for one match or separately pair with someone else for two matches. But still, according to rule #6 each player can only play at most one match in each tie play.

### Tie Scoring

Winning a match = 1 point

Win: If the team has won 4 or more matches.

Draw: If each team has won exactly 3 matches.

Loss: If a team has won less than or equal to 2 matches.

Default matches are recorded as 1-0 win for matches and 31-0 for games.

At the end of the tie, standing is determined by the number of points.

### Tournament Standings

The higher ranked team will be determined by the following criteria during the tournament, in the following order:

- Most # of Ties Won
- Most # of Ties Draw

- Most # of Matched Won
- Winner of head to head ties during the tournament (only if there is a 2 way tie)

## Team Organization Rules and Regulations

1. A team roster will consist of a minimum of 12 players up to a maximum of 20 players (with a minimum of 4 females per roster)
2. Team members can only play for one team and each player can only play at most one match in each tie play during this two-day tournament.
3. A Tournament Tie consists of 3 Men's Doubles, 1 Women's Doubles and 2 Mixed Doubles matches
4. Matches are played in the following order: XD1 MD1 MD2 D MD3 XD2.
5. Each team should be responsible for providing two unused feather shuttlecocks before the start of each match. No free shuttlecocks will be provided by Elite Badminton except for A/B flight finals.
6. EBRD recommend SPEED 77/78 Chao Pai (Red or Purple) and Black.Aeroplane (EG1130), Yonex 30/40, Victor Master 3/Champions 1 for best performance
7. If two teams have a draw situation in playoff, "golden set" is determined by two team captains
  - a) If TEAM A and Team B both select the same event, then this event will be the final event.(A choose MD B choose MD = play MD)
  - b) If TEAM A and Team B select different events, then the unchosen remaining event will be the final event. (A choose MD B choose WD = play XD)

## Prize

Possible 2 Divisions A/B A= Competitive Level, B=Recreational Level. Prize for A/B flight winners and finalists as well as raffle tickets during the tournament day for every participant.

## Parking
